

National Strategy "A barrier-free society for people with disabilities", 2016-2020 and the Operational Plan for its implementation

DIRECTIONS OF ACTION

The Strategy focuses on eight main policy directions for the implementation of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities adopted at New York by the United Nations General Assembly on 13 December 2006, opened for signature on 30 March 2007 and signed by Romania on 26 September 2007, ratified by Law no. 221/2010.

These are: accessibility, participation, equality, employment, education and training, social protection, health and statistics and data collection.

Each line of action includes: an analysis of the current situation, the general objective and the specific objectives. In the Operational Plan, the specific objectives are detailed in the measures, with the expected results being measured in the result indicators. The deadlines for implementing the measures, the responsible for the implementation of the measures and the necessary financial resources are set for each measure in the Operational Plan.

General Objective for social protection direction - Promoting and protecting the right of persons with disabilities to an adequate standard of living to continually improve the quality of their lives.

Specialized, day-to-day social services tailored to the needs to which people with disabilities should have access are extremely limited and geographically dispersed.

At country level, there were only 56 non-residential services on December 31, 2014, the number of adults with a disability being 2673.

The strategy aims to develop the network of non-residential services for people with disabilities in the community based on the assessment of individual needs, services that contribute substantially to increasing autonomy, while avoiding neglect and marginalization.
